ALDOT recognizes this unforeseen situation, we all are in, regarding the COVID-19 virus and the difficulties this creates for basic everyday tasks. Recently applications for FY 2021 were distributed with a due date of May 1, 2020. Considering the current environment, we are facing, specifically the social distancing recommendations alone will make the completion of your grant application virtually impossible. Therefore, ALDOT has taken the necessary action to continue level funding for Operation and Admin only, for your organization in FY 2021, using supplemental agreements. ALDOT will still take on vehicle capital. There will be no new construction projects started in FY 2021. The supplemental agreements will extend the time of performance for two years, thus having an end date of September 30, 2022.

Attached you will find a supplemental agreement for your agency. Please complete the attached agreement and the chart of allocation cost sheets from your application. Scan and email the completed documents to your Regional Manager and copy Mrs. Jazmyne Goodwin @ goodwinj@dot.state.al.us then mail the originals to ALDOT for further handling. Keep in mind the actual applications will have to be completed and submitted to ALDOT in the near future for compliance.
