


How Covid-19 Changed Our Routines?





The Circles of Influence



Defensive Driving



Close Quarters Maneuvering

- Backing and slow forward maneuvers
- Collisions with stationary objects
- Operating in confined spaces



Close Quarter Hazard Identification

- ► Sides: Backing in, other vehicles on both sides
- ▶ Front: Don't forget the car in the hard to see area to the right!
- ▶ Back: What is in the area behind me?



Close Quarters Maneuvering (Cont.)

Minimizing Risk using GOAL





Vehicle Maintenance and Hazardous Driving

Knowing dashboard lights/Indicators



- ▶ Pull off at safe location
- Turn engine off
- **Do not** open the hood until gauge is on cool
- **Do not** open radiator cap
- Calm passengers





Vehicle Maintenance and Hazardous Driving (Cont.)

- ► How to Drive Through a Tire Blowout
 - ▶ Keep a firm grip on the steering wheel.
 - ▶ Do not slam on the brakes.
 - ▶ Let your car slow down gradually.
 - ▶ Pull to the side of the road once you have slowed to a safe speed.
 - ► Activate your emergency flashers.
 - ▶ Maintain a safe distance with the road.
 - ▶ Make sure to explain to passengers and calm them down.



Vehicle Maintenance and Hazardous Driving

(Cont.)

Windy Driving



- ▶ Drive below the speed limit.
- ▶ Turn on your headlights and maintain a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you.
- ▶ Be constantly on the lookout for foreign objects.



Vehicle Maintenance and Hazardous Driving (Cont.)

- Rainy Driving
 - ▶ Importance of checking tire tread before driving
 - ► Think about the weather
 - ▶ Slow down
 - ▶ Use headlights and wipers
 - Avoid hard braking
 - ▶ Watch for standing water
 - ▶ Don't brake when hydroplaning
 - ▶ Ventilate your bus
